COMMITTEE DETAILS



UNGA

The United Nations General Assembly is the main deliberative body of the UN, where all member states have an equal voice. This session focuses on the pressing issue of the role of Artificial Intelligence in modern warfare. Delegates will explore the ethical, legal, and security implications of AI in conflict, discussing how international laws and norms should evolve to address the challenges posed by this transformative technology.

AGENDA: THE ROLE OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN MODERN WARFARE



UNHRC

The United Nations Human Rights Council is tasked with promoting and protecting human rights globally. This session will delve into the Israel-Palestine conflict, one of the most enduring and contentious issues in modern history. Delegates will analyze the conflict's human rights implications, exploring the impact on civilians, the role of international law, and potential pathways toward peace while ensuring the protection of fundamental human rights for all affected.

AGENDA: THE ISRAEL-PALESTINE CONFLICT AND ITS HUMAN RIGHTS IMPLICATIONS



UNW

United Nations Women is dedicated to gender equality and the empowerment of women. In this session, delegates will discuss gender-based laws, policies, and the global treatment of women. The committee will examine the effectiveness of existing legal frameworks, identify gaps in policy implementation, and propose solutions to address systemic gender inequalities. The goal is to foster a global environment where women's rights are upheld, and gender-based discrimination is eradicated.

AGENDA: DISCUSSING GENDER-BASED LAWS, POLICIES, AND THE GLOBAL TREATMENT OF WOMEN



LOK SABHA (Indian Committee)

The Lok Sabha, the lower house of India's Parliament, plays a critical role in shaping national policy. This session addresses the challenges of refugees and internally displaced persons in India. Delegates will evaluate the current policies, the humanitarian and security concerns involved, and the need for a comprehensive approach to protect vulnerable populations. The discussion will focus on balancing national interests with the ethical obligations to provide refuge and support to those in need.

AGENDA: ADDRESSING THE CHALLENGES OF REFUGEES AND INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS IN INDIA



UNSC

The United Nations Security Council (UNSC) addresses international peace and security issues. In this session, the focus is on territorial disputes in the South China Sea, a region fraught with competing claims from several nations. Delegates will examine the impact of these disputes on regional stability and international shipping, exploring strategies for peaceful resolution and adherence to international laws.

AGENDA: TERRITORIAL DISPUTES IN SOUTH CHINA SEA



INTERNATIONAL PRESS

The International Press is a critical component of Model United Nations, serving as the voice that reports on the proceedings and debates. Delegates in the International Press cover committee sessions, conduct interviews, and provide analysis on key issues.
