We at Assisi greatly appreciate your understanding and flexibility as you are going through a different academic experience. We would like to thank the parent community for the wholehearted support they are giving to the Institution and the teachers.

As an online learner, **self-motivation and self-discipline** are of paramount importance. This means that you are completely responsible for establishing and maintaining a **regular study system** and **the same standards of excellence** that are required in the face to face classes. You should be aware that self-discipline leads to **systematic study habit** and is the essential ingredient to achieve good results in the examinations.

Teachers are helping students with the lessons and also clarifying doubts. An interactive class with engaging questions makes the classes lively and **enhances learning** in students. Students, should **cooperate with teachers** by giving responses to the questions asked. It has been observed by the teachers that students are **reluctant to give responses** when they are asked a question. This attitude has to be changed and for this Parents should ensure that their ward is learning at home and giving responses to the questions asked in the online classes. Students, should be active learners in the online class and for this they should ask doubts to teachers. This would also help them to remain focused on the class.

The Unit Test begins for various classes on **Monday, 6 July 2020**. The tests will be of one-hour duration and maximum marks allotted for each subject will be 25. The teachers will be sharing the link to the question paper in the Chat Room after all the students are admitted in the Google Meet. The answers should be written on **legal size ruled paper**. On the answer sheet the student should write the Full Name, Roll No, Class, Division and Exam Name as written in the Question Paper. The soft copy of the answer sheets should be uploaded within the stipulated time, in pdf format.

Students must **file the hard copy of the answer sheets neatly** and submit the files to the teachers when the school reopens. We may have to upload the same on the CBSE site. The turned in or submitted answer sheets will be corrected and returned to the students and the soft copy will be saved in the school's server.

As you have read in the newspapers CBSE is taking into consideration the School **internal assessment marks** conducted for students in the Regions where AISSE or AISSCE exams could not be conducted. Furthermore, when you have to **pursue higher studies** after your Class XII the internal assessment marks are taken into consideration for admissions by many higher educational Institutions Since we are going through an unprecedented situation, we have to prepare ourselves for any type of evaluation methods and assessment criteria. So students should take every examination seriously. The marks of the internal assessments need to be uploaded on the CBSE site for Classes IX and X. A scheme has been formulated by CBSE for uploading the internal assessment marks of Class XI and XII students as well and this will be shared shortly.

The timetable for the upcoming exams is attached along with this circular. The exam is scheduled from 9:00 am to 10:00 am. On exam days the regular classes will begin at 10:30 am and continue till 2:30 pm. There will be lunch break with half an hour duration. The portions will be intimated in the group by the respective subject teachers.
